INGREDIENTS



From Snow (9900 11), cut:

- * {A} (4) 1" x 61/2" strips
- * {B} (2) 134" x 21/2" rectangles
- * {C} (1) 13/4" x 2" rectangles

From Peacock (9900 216), cut:


* {D} (2) 134" x 414" rectangles


From Country Red (9900 17), cut:

* {E} (1) 2" x 51/4" rectangles

From Template F, cut:

* {F} (3) flames from yellow/gold fabric OR use template to mark and embroider with yellow embroidery floss

YIELD 6½" square unfinished



WARM EVENING GLOW

STEP 1. MAKE CANDLES

Stitch background rectangles to the tops of the candle bases. Press. Sew 1" x $6\frac{1}{2}$ " background strips in between to create the candles. Press.



STEP 2. MAKE FLAMES

Use your favorite method of applique to add the flames.

Alternatively, the flames can be stitched using a yellow embroidery floss. Use the template and non-permnent marking pen to transfer the design to your block. Outline using a simple stitch.

Completed block measures 6½" square unfinished.
