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# **Quilters Basics**

Read instructions before beginning a project. All instructions include a ¼" seam allowance. Press as you go. Press seams in one direction.

#### Fabric 6 Green Tree Print

Cut 3 – 2"x22" strips Subcut – 22– 2"x2" squares for 4-Patch

#### Fabric 7 Red Bella Solid

20 – 1¼"xWOF strips Subcut – 39– 1¼"x22" strips for Strip Sets

#### Fabric 8 White Tonal

37 - 1¼"xWOF strips Subcut - 39 - 1¼"x22" strips for Strip Sets and 18 - 1¼"x16¼" strips for sashings 16 - 1¼"x18½" strips for sashings
1 - 3½"xWOF strip Subcut - 1 - 3½"x 6½" rectangle for date block

#### Fabric 9 Red Tree Print

First Cut:  $2 - 6\frac{1}{2}$ "x **Length** of fabric border strips Then Cut:  $6 - 6\frac{1}{2}$ "x WOF (approx. 27") strips from remainder for top and bottom borders



Fussy Cut 22 – 2" x2" squares for 4-Patch blocks

# CUTTING

#### 1 Panel-green bkgd.

Cut panel into blocks measuring 11"x13" with seams

#### Fabric 1 Dark Green Print

7 - 2<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>"xWOF strips for binding
1 - 2"xWOF strip Subcut 12 - 2"x2" corner squares
6 - 1<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>"xWOF strips for inner border

**Fabric 2 Dark Blue Print** 1 – 2"xWOF strip Subcut 12 – 2"x2" corner squares

**Fabric 3 White Holly Print** 8 – 2"xWOF strips Subcut 12 – 2"x11" strips and 12 – 2"x13" strips for first panel block border

# Fabric 4 Red Tonal

11 – 2½"x WOF strips Subcut 12 – 2½"x 14" strips and 12 – 2½"x 20½" strips for second panel block border

#### Fabric 5 Red Santa Faces

Fussy Cut 22 – 2"x2" squares with Santa Face for 4-Patches. *See diagram.* 

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### CONSTRUCTION

#### 4-Patch Corner Blocks – Make 11

 Join 1- 2"x2" Fabric 5 square and 1–2"x2" Fabric 6. Press toward red. Then join1–2"x2" Fabric 6 square and 1–2"x2" Fabric 5.

Press toward red. Join units to make 4-patch. See diagram.

#### Checkerboard Sashings – Make 17

Make the following Strip Sets. Press all seams toward red. Hint: To avoid curves and distortion when working with multiple strips, press with a dry iron and sew alternate strips in opposite directions – i.e. stitch first set of strips from the left, then the next strip from the right and so on.

- 3- Strip Set A 6 strips Fabric 7(red) and 6 strips Fabric 8 (white)
- 2 -Strip Set B 5 red and 5 white
- 1 Strip Set C 6 white and 5 red
- 1 -Strip Set D 5 white and 6 red

From Strip Sets A Cut 32 – 1¼" segments from strip sets.

From Strip Sets B Cut 18 – 1<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub>" segments from strip sets.

From Strip Sets C Cut 9 – 1¼" segments from strip set.

From Strip Sets D Cut  $9 - 1\frac{1}{4}$ " segments from strip set.

#### Assemble Sashings

Horizontal Sashing Units – Make 8

For each of 8 sashing units you will need

4-Strip Set A segments and  $2-1\frac{1}{4}"x18\frac{1}{2}"$  Fabric 8 sashing strips

1. Join 2 Strip Set A segments end to end to make 1 checkerboard strip with 12 red and 12 white square. Repeat with second set of Strip Set A segments. Press all seams toward red.











3. Join strips from Steps 1 & 2 to make vertical checkerboard. Press.

Make 9

4. Add 1¼"x16¼" Fabric 8 sashing strips to opposite sides of checkerboard to complete vertical sashing unit. Repeat steps to make 9 vertical sashing units. Vertical Sashing Unit should measure 3½"x16¼" with seams.

## FRAMING THE PANEL BLOCKS

Veritical Sashing Unit Make 9 3½"x16¼" with seams

For each panel block you will need 2 - 2"x11" and 2 - 2"x13" Fabric 3 strips, 2 - 2<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>"x14" and 2 - 2<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>"x 20<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" Fabric 4 strips and 4 - 2"x2" corner squares. (Note: 3 panel blocks use Fabric 1 and 3 panel blocks use Fabric 2 for corner squares)

- 1. Sew 1 2"x11" Fabric 3 strip to opposite sides of a panel block. Press toward panel.
- 2. Add corner squares to opposite ends of 2 2"x13" Fabric 3 strips. Press toward corner square. *Note: The panel blocks with green holly border use blue corner squares.*
- 3. Add pieced strips from Step 2 to top and bottom of panel block. Press. Panel block should measure 14"x16" with seams. Repeat with remaining strips and blocks. 201/2"

#### ADD RED BORDER

- Sew 2<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>"x 14" Fabric 4 strips to opposite sides of framed panel blocks. Press toward red.
- Then add 2<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>"x 20<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" red strips to top and bottom of panel block.
   Press toward red. Block should measure 18<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>"x 20<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>".
- 3. Center and square up block to measure 161/4"x181/2" with seams.



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Layer, quilt and bind. Happy Holidays!
